



Sales will be made principally by Oliver Dowding. At times he may delegate this to Jane O'Meara. She will be fully briefed of her obligations in complying with all the relevant rules.

Oliver Dowding holds a personal licence. Oliver Dowding will ensure Jane O'Meara, who will occasionally make sales of alcohol is familiar with their obligations at all times, and will only dispense alcohol following full verbal and written instruction from Oliver Dowding.

Should anyone try to buy alcohol who is not fit to be sold it, they won't be sold it and a note will be made and filed in the onsite Refusals Register.

The alcohol will be stored within Apple HQ. This will be locked at all times except for ingress and egress by Oliver Dowding or any authorised staff or visitors.

A "Challenge 25" policy will operate at the premises and the premises licence holders shall put measures in place so that the person making deliveries shall also operate this policy.

Full training will be given by the designated premises supervisor (DPS) to anyone involved in the sale of alcohol who doesn't have a personal licence. This training shall include but is not limited to the "Challenge 25" policy and the offences that can be committed under the licensing act 2003. Such training shall be fully documented and measures put in place so that the records are signed and dated by the DPS and the person being trained and will be available to authorised officers of the responsible authority upon request.


## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

By ensuring only responsible people are allowed in the premises.

Any people who appear irresponsible will not be sold any alcohol, whether on the premises of when delivering to purchasers.

The alcohol storage area (the whole of Apple HQ) will be locked at all times except for ingress and egress.

A refusals register will be kept on the premises and reviewed weekly by Oliver Dowding as the Designated Premises Supervisor. This will be made available to the Responsible Authorities on request.

  - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
  - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling
